In Base Putting to earn a point a player is to make a putt or have all putts finish in a specific distance radius from the hole.

Base Putting: Total Points 100

3 ft 20 balls – 20 points (1 point for each make)

5 ft 20 balls – 20 points (1 point for each make)

10 ft 10 balls – 10 points (1 point for each putt 1 ft radius)

15 ft 10 balls – 10 points (1 point for each putt 1.5 ft radius)

20 ft 10 balls – 10 points (1 point for each putt 2 ft radius)

25 ft 10 balls – 10 points (1 point for each putt 2.5 ft radius)

30 ft 10 balls – 10 points (1 point for each putt 3 ft radius)

40 ft 10 balls – 10 points (1 point for each putt 4 ft radius)

Notes: Putts should be relatively flat and straight
