In Base Short Game to earn a point a player is to make all shots finish in the hole or a circle that a specific distance radius from the hole.

Base Short Game: Total Points 100

Chipping - minimal air more ground roll shot off the fringe of the green

30 ft 10 balls – 10 points (1 point for each chip 5 ft radius)

40 ft 10 balls – 10 points (1 point for each chip 5 ft radius)

50 ft 10 balls – 10 points (1 point for each chip 5 ft radius)

Pitching – must be lofted shot over and edge of the green

30 ft 10 balls – 10 points (1 point for each pitch 5 ft radius)

40 ft 10 balls – 10 points (1 point for each pitch 5 ft radius)

50 ft 10 balls – 10 points (1 point for each pitch 5 ft radius)

Note: Try to find a spot where you have to get over an edge of a green, land on a spot to allow the ball to roll into the 5 ft target circle.

Lob Shots – must be open face cut flop over a steep edge or bunker

20 ft 10 balls – 10 points (1 point for each lob 10 ft radius)

30 ft 10 balls – 10 points (1 point for each lob 10 ft radius)

Note: This is a wide open face shot designed to elevate very quickly with minimal roll upon landing. The wide open face and minimal roll differentiates this shot from a pitch shot.

Sand Shots

20 ft 10 balls – 10 points (1 point for each sand shot 10 ft radius)

30 ft 10 balls – 10 points (1 point for each sand shot 10 ft radius)
